

89. 1878 HUMBER-DOUBLEDAY Tricycle, This type of Tricycle was very successful on the track with its high gearing which is driven by chain to the front wheel, Owner: S. Ripley

- 96. 1959 AUSTIN A55 Cambridge Saloon, This vehicle has been stored in a garage for several years and is totally original with extras, Owner: E. Carpenter

1928 GUY BTX 6 Wheel Trolleybus with Christopher Dobson body, Entered service in Hastings 1st April 1928, used as mobile workshop during second world war, restored in 1953 for Coronation, withdrawn at end of trolleybus system in Hastings 1959, then converted to diesel and used as seafront service by M&D, purchased by HBC in 1980, now maintained by Hastings Trolleybus Restoration Group.
