

1928 GUY BTX TROLLEYBUS, DODSON OPEN TOP 56 SEATER. Entered service in the Hastings area to replace trams in 1928. Withdrawn 1940 and used as a service vehicle up to 1947. Renovated for use during Coronation year and finally ran as an electric vehicle on the last day of trolley buses in Hastings in 1959. Only known example of an open top Dodson trolleybus in existence in any condition anywhere.
