The Rodney Ansell Memorial Trophy

One of Hooe's Old Motor Club's most prestigious awards is the Rodney Ansell Memorial Trophy. This was presented to the club by Ken Cooke, his life long friend, after Rodney's tragic death in 1976.

This beautiful trophy is made from a genuine pre First World War Vulcan lorry radiator mascot, showing the God Vulcan standing by his anvil with hammer. It is not presented for any Concours award but to the vehicle representing those Rodney liked best: namely a good honest vehicle, well maintained, well used and showing signs, and sometimes a few scars, of a long useful life.

Some of you here today who are veterans of the Hooe rallies may well remember Rodney driving his Model T Ford from the depths of Romney Marsh, with his Gran sitting in the car complete with shotgun, for their entry into the Car & Lady competition as the Clampetts from the popular series of the time, the Beverley Hillbillies.


