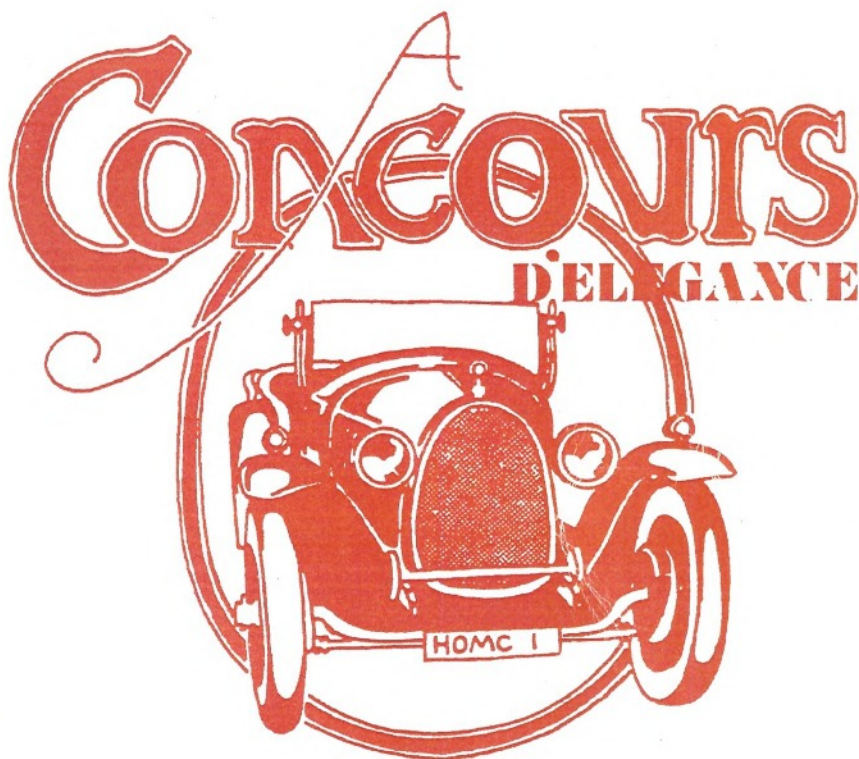

Well it's that time of year again.


