We are fortunate to have on display in Class B the 114 Panhard et Le Vasseur Type X22. This 135" wheel base, large chassis Panhard et Le Vasseur with coach work by Driguet of Paris is propelled by a 28hp, 4949cc, four cylinder Panhard Knight sleeve valve engine with a side mounted four speed gate change gear box. It has two floor mounted throttle pedals linked to a two speed carburettor, one for town driving, the other for faster out of town driving, which is also linked to the lubrication system. This increases the oil flow as the engine speed increases. Braking is to the rear wheels only with two massive 18" drums controlled 50% by foot brake and 50% by hand brake. The build sheets show that the Panhard was built to special order. The running chassis left the works in 1914 for the coach builders Driguet of Paris. The final invoice is dated 16th January 1915 to W & G Du Cros of Action Vale, London. W & G Du Cros were one of the largest new vehicle dealers in England. They also ran the largest taxi fleet in London. Harvey Du Cros Senior was the founder and only president of the Dunlop Rubber Co. He represented Hastings in the House of Commons 1906-08 and was Chairman of the Royal Automobile Club. The early history of the car is a little vague, but at some time it found its way back to France during the Great War, and is reported to have been used by Marshal (General) Foch as a parade car after the war. It certainly must have seen service during the war as O/D paint was found on the car. In 1938 the car resurfaced in New York where we believe it had work carried out by the famous Zumbach Motor Repair Co, including the fitting of Houdaille shock absorbers. Maurice Houdaille (1880-1953) invented the double action rotary shock absorber that bears his name. In 1978 Ed Heltemes, President of the Veteran Car Club of America purchased the Panhard and successfully completed the 1979 Cam Am Trans Continental Tour. Since then the car has had owners in Ireland, UK, Greece and purchased by the current owner in 2007 from a London dealer.

"FOXY LADY" 1932 CHEVROLET CONFEDERATE DELUXE SPECIAL SEDAN "THE GREAT AMERICAN VALUE"

When General Motors introduced the 1932 Chevrolet Confederate models (17 variations in all), they were called "The Great American Value" which was certainly true when the standard model started at just \$445 (approximately £110)! At that time the exchange rate was \$4.00+ to the £1.00!

The Wall Street crash of 1929 had taken a bitter toll on car production, so three years later GM had to do something sensational to make sales. The result was the Confederate, voted the prettiest Chevrolet of its period and nicknamed "the baby Cadillac".

This year's programme cover features the top-of-the-range five seater Sedan owned by club member Bruce Moore. The car sold for \$630 (£150) and boasted a six cylinder 3.2 litre engine up-rated to 60HP, synchromesh gearbox (on second and top gears), free-wheeling for greater economy, and a five cross-member chassis for added strength — all features associated with more expensive cars.

She was imported four years ago from New Jersey USA, already partly restored, by the present owner who spent a further three years "improving" the car. Top speed purported 65mph, though today she is kept to a maximum of 45mph and does approximately 20+mpg.

Total production for 1932 was 313,414 of which 52,446 of this model were built.

The Wall Street crash of 1929 had taken a bitter toll on car production, so three years later GM had to do something sensational to make sales. The radiator shell design was remodelled from the Cadillac, as were the "doors" in the hood sides, the screen was raked and the result was the Confederate, the prettiest Chevrolet of its period and nicknamed "the baby Cadillac".




