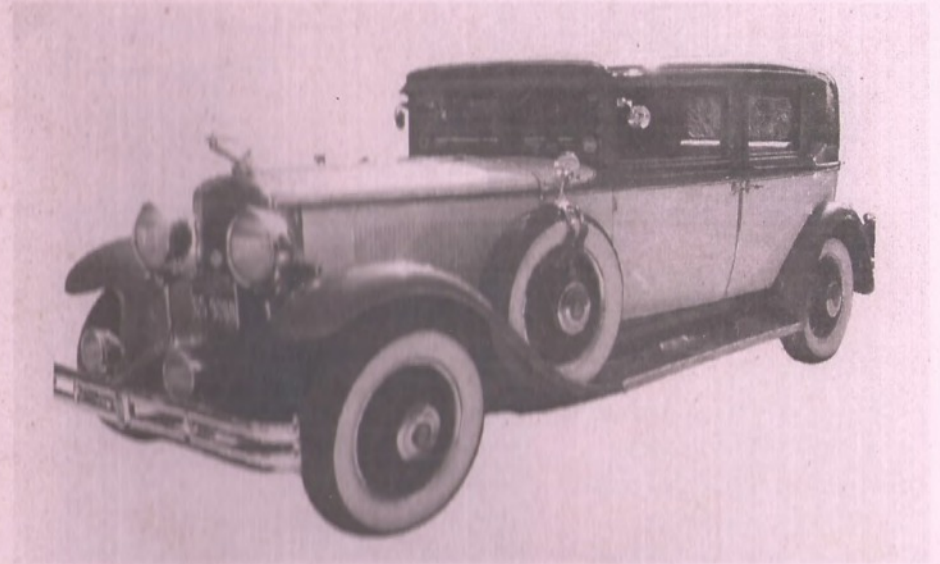

Nash Motors of Kenosha, Wisconsin USA, was founded in 1916 by former General Motors president Charles. W. Nash

The Nash 490 series was the company's top-of-the-line offering for 1930. It was powered by the company's first eight-cylinder motor - a twin ignition eight that developed 100 horsepower.

For 1930 the wheelbase of the senior series Nash automobiles was lengthened to 124 and 133 inches - the largest Nashes built to that date.

Standard equipment included: automatic radiator shutters, central lubrication system, electric clock, safety glass, oil filter and automatic fan clutch. Optional equipment on this car included dual side-mounted spares, 6.50 x 19 wire wheels and a rear-mounted trunk.

It has a straight eight ohv engine with a capacity of 8 litres, and uses two spark plugs per cylinder. Rated at 100hp.

Fuel tank capacity 19 gals, engine oil - 2 gals, radiator and engine water capacity 5.5 gals. Kerbside weight 4,145 lbs; originally sold new for around \$1695.
